In order for camp to be safe, fun and enjoyable for everyone, there are some expectations you and your child need to talk about before coming to Camp. Please read and discuss this letter, then sign and return it with his or her other registration materials.

EXPECTATIONS

1. Each camper must treat everyone else at camp with respect and consideration. Camp will not tolerate intimidation, verbal, emotional or physical abuse, or destruction of property.
2. Alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, smoking, or tobacco products are not allowed.
3. Guns, knives, slingshots, fireworks or any other kinds of weapons are not allowed.
4. Physical aggression, sexual, or suggestive behavior is not acceptable and will not be tolerated.
5. We expect all campers to be respectful and responsible at all times, including offsite trips.
6. Cussing, swearing, and foul language is not acceptable and will not be tolerated.

If at any time a camper is unable to uphold these expectations or behaves in a manner which jeopardizes the physical and/or emotional safety of him/herself, other campers, 7Summits Camp staff or the integrity of the camp program, the Camp Director will notify the parent(s) or guardian and steps will be taken to resolve the situation.
